Removed from Landmark Status by City Council: March 27, 2007

Description: The Earl Anderson home is a Bungalow-style, wood-sided, house. It has a cross-gabled roof with multiple planes. The house features wood-framed, double-hung windows and a brick chimney. A wrap around, trellis porch was added after the home was built, which blends well with the style of the structure. The porch is supported by brick and wooden posts.
