- Amplified music is not allowed
- Typical functions held at the Museum include:

Main floor – 15 round tables; 120 chairs*

Auditorium – 8 round tables; 100 chairs in rows*

*Tables and chairs must be rented at the Museum.

The first 20 chairs are included with the rental of the facility.

- No kitchen facility available – caterers only (small catering kitchen)
