

CO-SPONSORED YOUTH SPORTS ORGANIZATIONS

The City of Modesto Parks, Recreation and Neighborhoods Department co-sponsors various non-profit youth sports organizations. The program allows approved youth sports organizations to use reservable fields for practices and games.

Interested organizations must submit a new application on a yearly basis. All organizations must be tax-exempt in accordance with the Internal Revenue Service, Section 501(c)(3) and with the California Franchise Tax Board, Section 23701(d).

Financial Assistance Program

Leisure Buck ID cards must be obtained before registering for classes.

Processing time is 10-14 working days.

Who: Low-income youth, seniors and disabled persons living within the Modesto city limits who wish to participate in Parks, Recreation and Neighborhoods Department programs or City-approved youth sports organization leagues. Must meet age and income guidelines.

What: Assistance will be granted to pay a portion of registration fees for programs that cost \$5 and above. May not be used for excursions. Participants will be required to pay the remaining portion at time of registration.
