- Odd-numbered addresses watering days are Wednesday, Friday and Sunday
- Even-numbered addresses watering days are Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday
- No outdoor water use on Monday and daily between 12:00pm and 7:00pm (\*refer to exceptions below)
  - \* *Use of drip irrigation, hand watering of trees, shrubs and car washing with use of a positive shutoff nozzle is permitted at any time*
  - \* *Hosing concrete areas, building exteriors, etc. is prohibited except for health/safety concerns or for maintenance/ construction purposes, with use of a positive shutoff nozzle*
- Water leaks must be repaired within 24 hours
- No irrigating turf or ornamental landscapes during and 48 hours following measurable rain (.01 inch). For measurable rain data refer to *mid.org/weather*
- Outdoor watering must be kept on your property...avoid water runoff

### ATTENTION: TURLOCK, GRAYSON, CERES WALNUT MANOR, AND DEL RIO

**Important Note:** Outlying water systems owned by the City will remain on a two day watering schedule because they are solely supplied by groundwater wells. These include the Turlock, Grayson, Ceres Walnut Manor & Del Rio water systems.

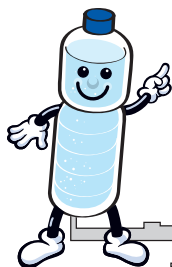
