Be sure to attend the free Boyett B Green Recycling Event held on Stoddard Avenue between Park and Sycamore Avenues. This is a convenient drive thru event where all recyclables donated are matched dollar for dollar by Boyett Petroleum. 100% of the funds are applied to the City of Modesto "Adopt a Park" Program to complete funding of the endowment for the new dog park at Elk Park and more park planned improvements. Items accepted for recycling include:

- On site document shredding (limit of 5 file boxes or grocery bars per person)
- CRV Bottles, Cans, Plastic & Scrap Metal
- E-Waste (TV's, computers, laptops, video games, electronics, etc.)
- Ink Jet, toners, cartridges

In addition, Covanta Energy will also be collecting small batteries and cell phones. Look for their booth!

This year's entertainment includes music from local artist and 2012 MAMA award winner The-High-Voltage-Band, returning Country favorite Southern Bend, the Pendletons and a demonstration from the Modesto Police Departments K9 Unit. IMPORTANT NOTICE

In 2011 Governor Brown signed Assembly Bill (AB) 341 into law and it became effective January 1, 2012. If you own and/or operate a business or have rental properties in California, this new law MAY impact you. Assembly Bill 341 now requires businesses that produce four or more cubic yards of waste per week, and multifamily residences with five or more dwellings, to recycle, reuse and/or divert some of their waste from disposal.

Businesses in the City of Modesto that meet the above threshold must place recyclable materials in the bins or containers provided by their local garbage collection company, or may also donate, sell and/or make other arrangements for pick up and recycling of the materials to a "not for profit" organization. Businesses may also self-haul the materials to a recycling facility. Businesses must retain documentation and/or proof of receipt of method of recycling and make it available for inspection by the City of Modesto or CalRecycle upon request.

City of Modesto Water Conservation Rebates

High Efficiency Toilet Rebate Program

The City of Modesto is offering a rebate for qualifying High Efficiency Toilets purchased between January 1, 2013 and June 30, 2013. Toilets are the biggest water user in your home! They account for nearly 30% of a home's indoor water use. If you replace an "old water guzzler" with a new "Water-Sense" labeled high efficiency model it can decrease your water use by 11 gallons per toilet each day. City of Modesto residential customers in single and multi-family homes may be eligible for a rebate when replacing an old high-water-use toilet. High Efficiency Clothes Washer Rebate Program

The City of Modesto is offering a rebate for qualifying clothes washer machines purchased between January 1, 2013 and June 30, 2013. Clothes washers are typically the second largest user of water indoors. Replacing your old washer with a new high-efficiency model can save water. City of Modesto residential customers in single and multi-family homes may be eligible for a rebate.
