RESOLUTION NO. 2015-03

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE CITY COUNCIL ACCEPT THE
CROWS LANDING ROAD CORRIDOR STUDY

WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting of March 27, 2012, City Council approved Resolution 2012-126 authorizing submittal of a grant application to the California Department of Transportation requesting \$550,000 in Community-Based Transportation Planning Grant Funds for corridor studies; and

WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting of September 25, 2012, City Council approved Resolution 2010-395 accepting \$247,500 of Environmental Justice Planning Grant funds for a Crows Landing Road corridor study, Resolution 2010-396 amending the budget to reflect the grant; and

WHEREAS, Planning Division staff held public workshops on September 26, 2013, August 26, 2014, and November 20, 2014, to solicit public input on the Crows Landing Road corridor study; and

WHEREAS, the corridor study considered and evaluated two main options to developing Crows Landing Road; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends, based upon public input and safety concerns, redesignation of Crows Landing Road to a 100-foot, four-lane minor arterial with bike lanes, as described in Chapter 7 of the Crows Landing Road corridor study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Planning Commission that it hereby recommends City Council accept the Crows Landing Road corridor study.

The foregoing resolution was introduced at the regular meeting of the Planning Commission held on January 5, 2015, by Chris Tyler, who moved its adoption, which motion was seconded by Mani Grewal, and carried by the following vote:
