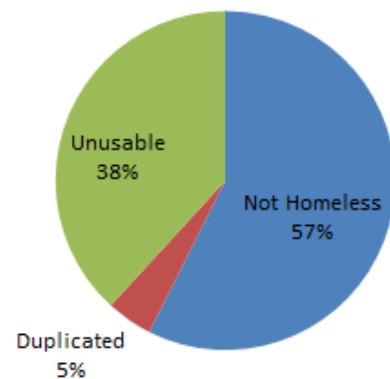

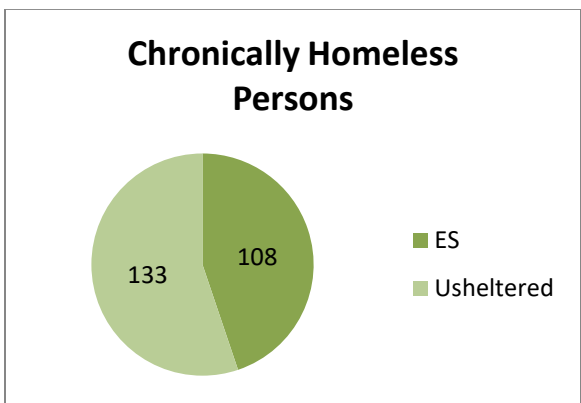
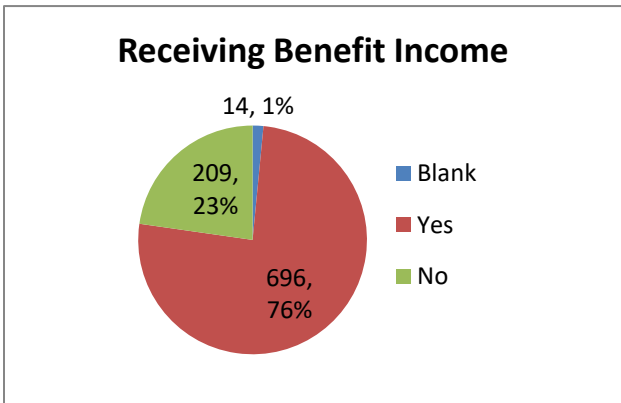
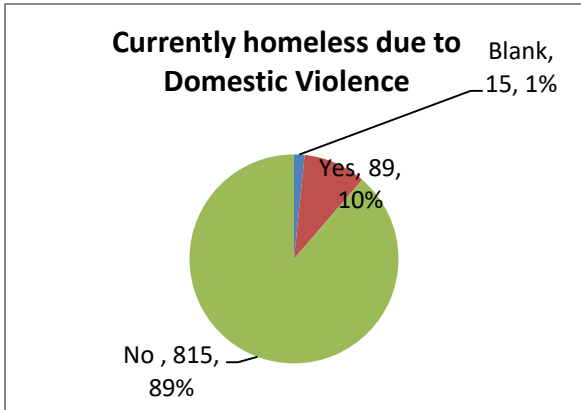
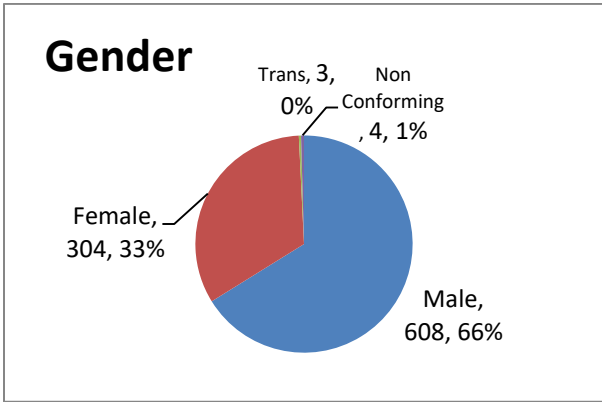
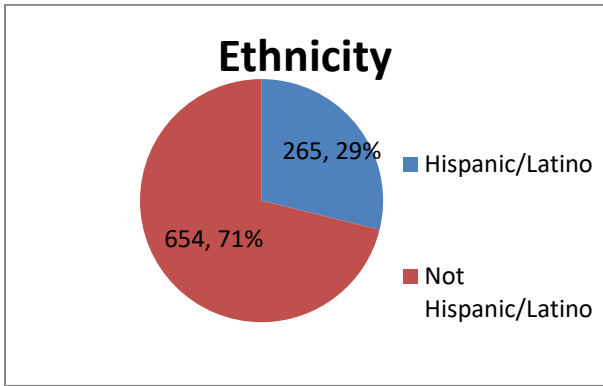
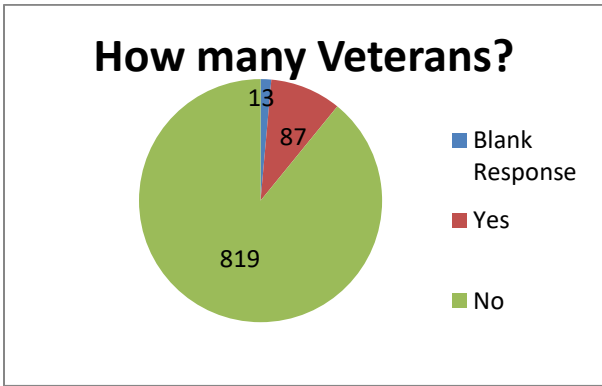


Reasons Became Homeless Continued



Where are you sleeping tonight?





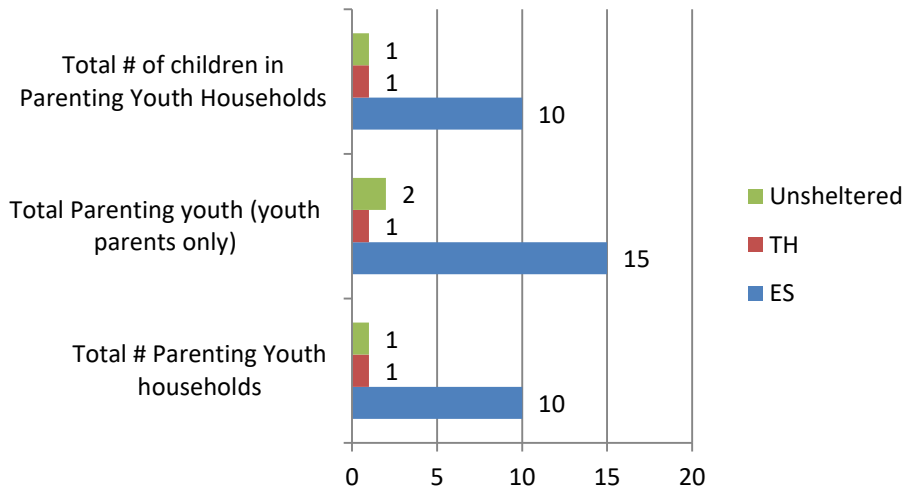
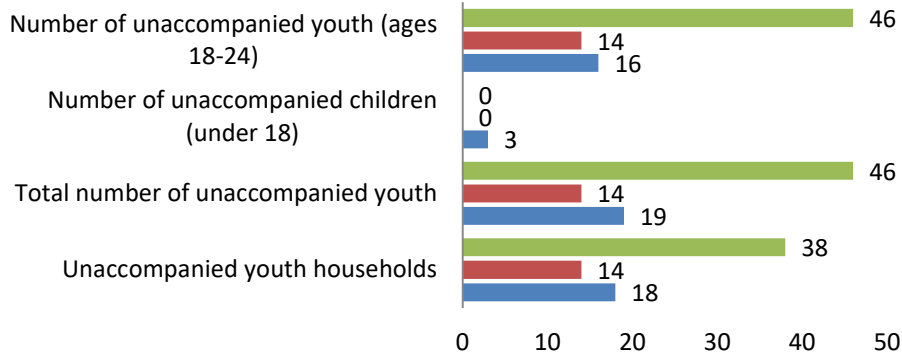
