Project Summary:

The City of Modesto Public Works Streets Division will complete 118 lane miles of slurry seal during the 2018 slurry season.

Project Description:

Slurry seal is a pavement preservation method consisting of an asphalt emulsion, sand, and rock which is applied to the street surface at an average thickness of 1/4 inch. This cost effective maintenance treatment extends the life of streets already in fair to good condition.

Slurry seal provides a durable riding surface and addresses any existing distresses on streets. It protects streets from water penetration, and provides a new wearing surface and improved skid-resistance. Slurry seal is a quick and economical maintenance strategy.
