### Project Summary:

This project will purchase five electric buses and associated charging stations at the Bus Maintenance Facility.

### Project Description:

The electric buses will be 40-foot buses, with eight charging stations. This will enable expansion of the electric bus fleet in the future. These buses are required to operate on MAX routes 21 and 42 until the grant agreement is complete. These extended range buses have a range of 350 miles. The routes they will operate on are between 130-180 miles. The range can vary due to weather, passenger loads and grades.

### Funding:

This project is funded with grants from the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District, the Federal Transit Administration, the Public Transportation Modernization and Service Enhancement Account program and the Transportation Development Act.
