### Project Summary:

Fleet Services is currently divided in two buildings with two parts storage locations. This parts room will add the additional parts storage required for all shops and provide a connection between the Bus Maintenance Facility and the proposed heavy duty shop building for streamlined labor sharing.

### Project Description:

Currently Fleet has operations to maintain its bus fleet in a newly built Bus Maintenance Facility. This is a state of the art facility designed to maintain all of the City Fixed Route and Commuter buses in the City's fleet. All other vehicle parts are stored in another building. As part of a Fleet Efficiency Study that was performed in 2017, it was recommended that all parts be stored in one location for better control. This parts room expansion project will allow all of Fleet parts to be stored in one secure location. It will also allow for a connecting hallway that will eventually tie into a new heavy duty shop.

### Benefits:

This grant funded construction of this parts room expansion will allow Fleet Services to work toward being in one building, allowing labor and resource sharing, as well as centralized parts and tires.
