Project Summary:

This project will expand the Transit Center to provide more dispatching space for the Modesto Area Express operation.

Project Description:

The plans for this project are to reconfigure and enlarge the existing customer service and operational administrative space. The customer service space will be moved to the main lobby, where there is a historical customer service window. This will allow more area for customers to wait in a comfortable environment. Often, during the beginning of the month, the line for monthly pass sales will extend out of the existing customer service space to the outside sidewalk. Also, an additional customer service window will allow quicker service for fare media sales and transit questions. As StaRT and Altamont Commuter Express (ACE) request customer service and administrative space, this new area could be reconfigured to accommodate those requests
