### Virginia Corridor Trail Maintenance

#### **Project Description:**

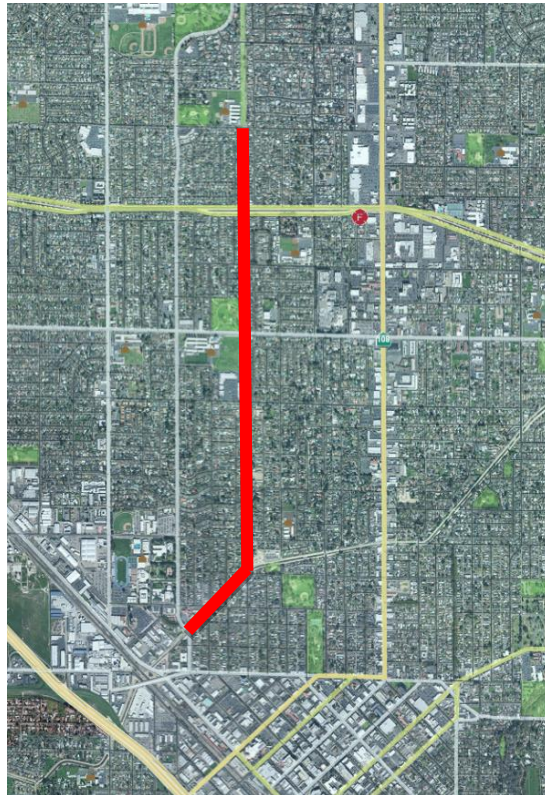
Pavement maintenance project on Virginia Corridor Trail from College Avenue to Bowen Avenue, approximately 2.0 miles. Anticipated project improvements include bike path resurfacing, decomposed granite repairs, new center line striping, new signage, ADA upgrades, crossing at Stoddard Road and Orangeburg Avenue.
