9th Street Corridor Improvements

Project Description:

Upgrading the existing Class IV bike lane on 9th with a class I bike trail and then connecting it to the Transit Center. Rehabilitation of the existing pavement on 9th and reconfiguration the street into a collector street from Carpenter Road to Tully Road. Improved access to the Southbound 9th street bike lane from northbound side of the street with Ped Crossing on Carver from shopping center to Archway entrance. Sidewalk connection from Archway Commons along 9th Street north and new bus stops.
